Passed away after a valiant battle against lymphoma at London Health Sciences Centre, London, Ontario on June 5, 2015. Survived by his wife Margaret ("Jean") of Forest, Ontario; daughter Colleen Webster (Mac) of Forest; and son Kevin Glasgow (Sandy Bennett) of Toronto.
