

McINTYRE: Floyd

John McIntyre of Forest passed away at St. Joseph's Health Care Centre, Sarnia on Friday, October 18th, 1996 in his 74th year. Beloved son of the late John and Georgina (Wight) McIntyre.

Survived by several cousins and many friends. Floyd had a love of history and learning. He was the press reporter for the Lambton County Historical Society, and also for the Arkona and Area Historical Society, a member of the Forest Excelsior Band, the Forest United Church Choir. He had served on the Forest Council, reported news to several newspapers and spent much time checking into records for the First Nation Indian people. There

were many more committees that Floyd belong to also.

He rested at the Gilpin Funeral Chapel, Forest, for the service on Tuesday, October 22nd at 2:30 p.m. with Rev. Don Hudson of Forest United Church officiating. During the service Hylke Van der Wal spoke of Floyd's teaching and his many talents.

Interment was at Arkona Cemetery.
