Obituary: Margaret "Mag" Holmes was married to Bill Jackson. They lived at Pt. Lot 21 Con. 7 in West Williams. Bill was an uncle to Jean Peto and left her the farm when he died in 1974. They never had any children of their own, but they did raise Bill's sister's son Billy Bishop.

Remarks: Wm. Jackson was married to Margaret (Holmes). There was no stone on this plot for years because Bill was a stone mason and wanted to put his own stone on his plot, but the Cemetery Board said NO.

Obituary: Bill (1897-1974) Jackson was the son of Niles & Jannie Jackson of Parkhill. He was a bricklayer and stone mason. He married Margaret "Mag" Holmes (1896-1961) of West Williams, daughter of Jim Holmes. The Jackson's lived at Pt. Lot 21, Con. 7. They grew raspberries and provided employment to many of the young people in the area. Bill and Mag never had any children of their own, but they did raise Bill's sister's son, Billy Bishop. When Bill died, Jean Peto (1926), a niece, inherited the farm, so she and her husband Bert move in.
