

Gilliland—In Bosanquet, on Sunday, July 3rd, 1932, Charlotte Cunningham, wife of Mr. James Gilliland, in her 62nd year.

The death occurred at her home near Arkona, on Sunday evening, of Charlotte Cunningham, wife of James Gilliland, in her 62nd year, after an illness of about seven months. The deceased was born in Waterloo County and after their marriage in 1890, Mr. and Mrs. Gilliland lived in Waterloo for five years. They came to Bosanquet and for 15 years resided near Forest, later moving to Thedford, and about five years ago moved to near Arkona where they have lived since that time. She is survived by her husband and six sons and five daughters. The sons are Roy, of Woodstock; George, of New York; Earl, of St. Thomas; Ralph, of Bosanquet; Harold, of Saginaw, Mich., and Nelson, at home. The daughters are Mrs. Wes. Burr and Mrs. Fred Burr, of Plympton; Mrs. D. Anderson, of Bosanquet; Mrs. Cecil Dellow, of Woodstock, and Winnie, at home. The late Mrs. Gilliland was an active member of the Arkona United Church and until illness prevented, she was a regular attendant at the Sabbath services and interested in the different organizations of the church especially the Women's Missionary Society of the church. She was highly respected in the community for her kindly spirit and christian character, and during the past few months she showed remarkable courage as her health failed her during that time. The funeral was held on Tuesday afternoon with a service conducted by Rev. D. M. Guest, of the Arkona United Church. Interment was made in the Arkona cemetery, and the pallbearers were T. A. Lampman, E. Edwards, George Janney, George Donaldson, Herb. Benedict and Jos. Zavitz.
