

MRS. BENJAMIN MUMA

On Monday, May 21, 1962, Mrs. Benjamin Muma, a resident of Warwick township, passed away in Strathroy General Hospital, after five weeks' illness there, in her 91st year. She was formerly Mary Waterman and her late husband Benjamin Muma died in 1934.

Surviving are two sons, Frank and Russell of Arkona; three sisters, Mrs. Earl Ridley (Mabel) of Arkona; Mrs. Harvey Leggate (Winnifred) of Warwick Village; Miss Jean, of Dearborn, Mich.

The remains rested at the Harper Funeral Home, Watford, until Thursday afternoon at 3 o'clock, when Rev. J. P. Cooke of the Arkona United Church conducted the services. He was assisted by Rev. Mr. Daunt, of St. Mary's Anglican Church, Warwick, and interment was made in the Arkona cemetery.
