

Henry Mason Jones (1911 – 1971)

Mason Jones was born in Toronto in 1911; he graduated from the University of Toronto as a chemical engineer. He spent most of his business career with Canadian Industries Limited (in McMasterville, Quebec, and later in Hamilton). In 1968 Mason was appointed the first manager of the Lampton Industrial Society in Sarnia. The Society was made up of the major firms located in the St. Clair River valley - the mission was promoting collective effort to prevent industrial pollution. Mason was a member of the Sarnia Rotary Club and the Sarnia Yacht Club.

Throughout his life Mason enjoyed the outdoors and participated actively in camping, canoeing, sailing, and gardening activities. Mason encouraged young people and was active in the Boy Scout program.
