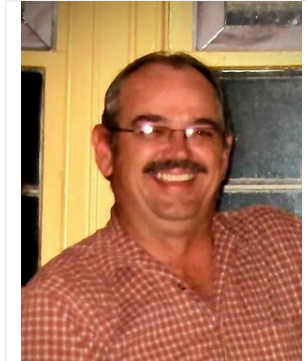


John Michael Fraser (Jake)
