REV. A. A. BARNES

Funeral service for the Rev. Arthur Barnes, retired minister, Arkona, was held in the Arkona United Church on Saturday afternoon, February 3, 1968 at 2:00 p.m., the Rev. Fred Antrobus of Arkona Baptist Church in charge, and taking part, various representatives of the Ministerial profession, including Baptists from Toronto.

Rev. Barnes died in Sarnia General Hospital on Wednesday, January 31, in his 77th year. The remains rested at the Gilpin Funeral Home until the funeral.

Deceased was the son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Frank E. Barnes of Warwick Township. He graduated from McMaster University, then in Toronto. In succession he served congregations in Wyoming, north of Toronto, Cobalt, Forest, Paris, Galt, Fort Erie. The last settled pastorate was Dresden. For a number of years since, however, he has supplied in various churches since his retirement in Arkona.

49 years ago he married Adella Davidson, who survives him. Also surviving are three sons and one daughter, Dr. C. A. Barnes, Ph. D., of Pasadena, California; Arthur F. Barnes of Corunna; W. David Barnes of Dundas, and Mrs. W. A. (Marion) F. of Galt, brother Frank Warwick Township, and 10 grandchildren.
